Moses Johnson joined the INSEL staff as Administrative Officer in August of 2011. His previous position was the Administrative Officer on the Joint Project Manager, Guardian staff at Joint Program Executive Office for Chemical, Biological Defense located in Aberdeen Proving Grounds, MD. Before working with JPM, Guardian, Moses was employed as a Federal Contractor supporting the Office of the Secretary of Defense, in Falls Church, VA.

A New York City native, Moses decided to join the United States Navy after graduating from high school in 1983 and enlisted in February 1984 into the administrative field as a Personnelman. His duty station stations included: USS Forrestal (CV-59), The Bureau of Naval Personnel (BUPERS), USS Mount Whitney (LCC-20), Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR), Patrol Squadron Twenty Six (VP-26) and Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing Five (COMPATRECONWING 5).

Moses received a number of decorations and personal awards while serving on active duty to include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and the Navy and Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal with four bronze stars in lieu of fifth award. Mr. Johnson retired after 20 years of service at the rank of Petty Officer First Class in 2004.
