

Industrial College of the Armed Forces Elective Studies Program AY10

The Industrial College of the Armed Forces (ICAF) Elective Studies Program gives students the opportunity to deepen or broaden their knowledge through elective courses. Students are required to take four elective courses for eight academic credit hours during the year. Electives are offered on a semester basis – fall and spring. Most elective courses earn two credit hours. Students take two elective courses each semester.

There are over 150 courses offered by the colleges and schools of the National Defense University (NDU). Students may select from all NDU, ICAF, National War College (NWC), Information Resources Management College (IRMC), and College of International Security Affairs (CISA) offerings with some restrictions on scheduling.

ICAF offers several special concentrations through the Elective Studies Program: the Senior Acquisition Course (SAC), the Supply Chain Management Concentration Program (SCMCP), the Information Operations Concentration Program (IOCP, an IRMC special program), and an Independent Study and Research Program. Students interested in these special programs must obtain approval from the Department and/or Program Director and Associate Dean as indicated in the course description prior to registering for electives.
