## **Mr. Mark C. Treanor**



Mark Treanor is Senior Partner of Treanor Pope & Hughes, a boutique suburban Maryland law firm he founded over twenty years ago. His practice focuses on complex corporate and commercial litigation, government and internal investigations, alternative dispute resolutions, regulatory matters and corporate and board governance. He is also Chairman (non-executive) of Virtus Investment Partners, Inc., a NASDAQ - traded asset management firm.

From 1999 until 2008, Mr. Treanor was the Senior Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Wachovia Corporation where he was responsible for legal, regulatory, legislative and major contracting matters for all domestic and global businesses, was a Director of Wachovia Bank, N. A., a member of the Corporation's Operating Committee, and chaired the Corporate Security Committee - focused on homeland security issues, and the Corporate Pandemic Planning Committee. In 2008, he was named one of the five best general counsel in the United States by Corporate Board Member Magazine.

He is a member of the Board of Visitors of the U.S. Naval Academy as well as the Board of Visitors of the National Defense University, where he has served on the Committee on Academics and Curriculums and as the Board's representative in the Department of Education accreditation process for the University's authority to confer a masters degree in the Joint Advanced Warfare Studies program.

Mr. Treanor is also a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and a member of Business Executives for National Security. He is former Chairman of the Advisory Committee to the Export-Import Bank of the United States, Chairman Emeritus of the National Defense University Foundation, a former member of the Board of Visitors of the University of Maryland School of Law, the Board of Directors of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Institute for Legal Reform, the Board of Advisors of the University of North Carolina Center for Banking and Finance, and the Financial Services Roundtable, where he chaired the Global Financial Issues Committee. He is a senior fellow of the American Leadership Forum. He has participated in Department of Defense - sponsored fact-finding missions to Iraq, the Horn of Africa, Yemen, the Caucasus and other locations in Africa and Europe.

A 1968 graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy, Mr. Treanor served as an infantry and artillery officer (2d Lieutenant - Captain, 1968 - 1973) in the U.S. Marine Corps. He is also a graduate of the University of Maryland School of Law, where he was a member of the Law Review and Order of the Coif.
