**DISTRIBUTION:** *JFQ* is distributed to the field and fleet through service channels. Military personnel and organizations interested in receiving the journal on a regular basis should make their requirements known through command channels. **SUBSCRIPTIONS:** *JFQ* is available by subscription from the Government Printing Office (see the order blank in this issue). **CONTRIBUTIONS:** *JFQ* welcomes submissions from members of the Armed Forces as well as from defense analysts and academic specialists from both this country and abroad, including foreign military officers and civilians. There is no required length for articles, but contributions of 3,000 to 5,000 words are appropriate. Other submissions, however, to include letters to the editor, items of commentary, and brief essays are invited. Reproductions of supporting material (such as maps and photos) should be submitted with manuscripts; do *not* send originals.

Manuscripts are reviewed by the Editorial Board, a process which takes two to three months. To facilitate review, provide three copies of the manuscript together with a 150-word summary. Place personal or biographical data on a separate sheet of paper and do not identify the author (or authors) in the body of the text. Follow any accepted style guide in preparing the manuscript, but endnotes rather than footnotes should be used. Bibliographies should not be included. Both the manuscript and endnotes should be typed in double-space with one-inch margins.

*JFQ* reserves the right to edit contributions to meet space limitations and conform to the journal’s style and format. Proofs of articles accepted for publication are not normally sent to authors for review.

Unless evidence of prior clearance is provided, all manuscripts selected for publication which are contributed by members of the U.S. Armed Forces or employees of the Federal Government are forwarded to the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Public Affairs to undergo security review. No honorarium or other form of payment is authorized for the publication of articles submitted by servicemembers or U.S. Government employees.

If possible submit the manuscript on a disk together with the typescript version. While 3.5- and 5.25-inch disks in various formats can be processed, WordPerfect is preferred (disks will be returned if requested).
