George C. Maerz is Supervisory Writer-Editor, National Defense University (NDU) Press.

Mr. Maerz has been with NDU Press since it was founded as the Research Directorate during the creation of the National Defense University in 1977. Since then, he has served as book editor, chief of the editorial and production branch, senior editor, and now as supervisory editor, helping to shape the development of the organization from a research support group into a major university press publisher.

Previously, Mr. Maerz was a technical editor, Textbook Development Branch, Extension Programs Directorate, Industrial College of the Armed Forces; technical editor, U.S. Army Concepts Analysis Agency; publications officer, U.S. Army Combat Developments Command; and military intelligence officer, U.S. Army.

Mr. Maerz earned a BA in English from Loyola College of Maryland, and received the college's Carrell Gold Medal in English. He has completed graduate courses in English at Georgetown University. Mr. Maerz has received Department of Army and Defense performance awards, including the Superior Civilian Service Medal (1997). He is the co-editor (with Giles Harlow) of the 1992 NDU Press book, *Measures Short of War: The George F. Kennan Lectures at the National War College*.
