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




NOTES: B/G/R = Blue, Green, Red = US, International Partners, Adversaries

The NAVIC



- Serves the NSS, Cabinet, Congress, and 50 Governors - does not make policy
- State-of-the-art facilities & processes
- Provide continuity in national security with expert civil servants
- Informational connectivity across breadth of actors
- Provides President multiple redundant command center capabilities in every state
- Emphasis on Visual aspects of understanding
- Emphasis on long-term thinking and doing
- Managed by one politically appointed executive director who works for the WH CofS
- Run by six 15-year appointed assistant directors for each function


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Five National Modular Teams
