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Executive Summary

The Joint Knowledge Development and Distribution Capability (JKDDC) is the executing office for joint certification of identified joint content since May 2006. To date, United States Joint Forces Command (USJFCOM) has signed certification packages for 260 of 384 identified courses. Of these certified courses, 146 total Joint Qualified Officer (JQO) points have been assigned (27 Distance Learning courses, and 119 Resident Learning courses).



Joint Officer Management (JOM) Background

The Department of Defense Joint Officer Management Joint Qualification System Implementation Plan, 30 March 2007, outlines the multi-level joint qualification concept and identifies lead and supporting organizations responsible for operationalizing it effective October 1, 2007.

Joint Qualified System (JQS)

The Goldwater-Nichols Department of Defense Reorganization Act of 1986 set the criteria for joint positions that the Defense Department has used ever since. The new Joint Qualification System, announced on July 30, 2007, keeps in place the tenets of the act, but allows for the post-9/11 operating environment. The new system, which takes effect Oct. 1, offers an additional "experience-based" track with a point system for recognizing joint service. The original track remains in place, but the second track allows for awarding partial credit or for awarding credit for an expanded list of joint positions. All original educational requirements remain in place, but some credit can be given for additional education, training and exercises.

The new system recognizes the skills that aid U.S. military efforts to respond to national security threats, as well as interagency, combat operations and humanitarian crises. It also accounts for the intensity, environment, and duration or frequency of a joint activity. A key change is the ability to award credit to reserve component officers, previously not allowed.

Active-duty officers will be able to recover credit for positions served since September 11, 2001. Reserve component officers who served in qualifying joint assignments from October 1, 1986, until September 30, 2007, may be awarded joint duty credit. As of October 1, 2008, active component officers are required to complete a full joint duty assignment and be designated a joint qualified officer for appointment to the rank of general or flag officer.



Joint Qualification System

The Joint Qualification System (JQS) authorized in NDAA 2007 (Public Law 109-364) provides a dual-track opportunity to earn joint qualifications.

Joint Qualified Officer (JQO) Points

JKDDC will continue to support the Joint Officer Management (JOM) program in its expansion of breadth and depth through FY08. JKDDC continues to serve as the action office for certification and scoring of individual Joint training in support of the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) chaired JOM board. JKDDC provides outreach and identifies new individual Joint training sources from the Combatant Commands (COCOMs), Services, and Combat Support Agencies (CSAs). As part of the FY08 Program Executive Plan (PEP), JKDDC plans to work with the Joint Staff and OSD to increase understanding of JQS and its alignment with the Joint Learning Continuum (JLC) within the joint community.

JQO Points are awarded on a basis of 1.0 point per 40 hours of training. For example, completion of a 20 hour joint certified Distance Learning course is awarded 0.5 JQO points.



Joint Certification Process

Joint certification originates with Enclosure H of the Joint Training Manual, CJCSM 3500.03B, signed 31 August 2007. In this document, USJFCOM JWFC J7 is identified to lead and manage the joint individual learning content certification process. The certification criteria are five-fold:

1. Content must meet a joint training requirement
2. Content should not conflict with joint doctrine. In every case, training content must support emerging concepts of high or special interest to the joint warfighting community.
3. Joint training objectives must link to current UJTL.
4. Media must incorporate assessment of each trainee to track achievement of the training objectives.
5. Media must support content assessment as part of life cycle management.

Any entity may identify joint content and provide data to support the five criteria. These criteria are examined, and if found to meet the requirements, a certification package is prepared which outlines the details. The certification package is staffed at USJFCOM J7. Once signed, the joint content is deemed to be joint certified. A list of the current joint content that has been identified and its certification status is provided in Appendix A.



JKDDC Total Inventory

JKDDC tracks all identified joint content in the Joint Knowledge Services Database (JKSD), which resides in Joint Knowledge Online (JKO) on the NIPRnet, SIPRnet and Internet Public portals. As of 15 January 2007, there are 356 records in the database. Users can search the JKSD by keyword, Universal Joint Task List (UJTL), or J-Code (see Figure 1).

Once search criteria are entered, the JKSD returns the Courseware Search Results page (see Figure 2). Each column can be filtered by making selections from the drop down menus. For example, a user can filter results by choosing Community of Interest, Distributed Learning, Institutional Learning, Job Aid, or Mobile Training Team from the 'Course Method' menu.

Users can view the 'Course Details' by clicking on any hyperlinked title in the Courseware Search Results list. This provides the user with the Course Title, Description, Course Number, Location, Certification date (if granted), JQO Points assigned (if any), Course Hours, Course Method, Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR), OPR Email, Scheduling



Point of Contact (POC), Scheduling POC Phone Number, Scheduling POC Email, Classification, Assessment Method, and UJTL's Referenced.

JOINT INDIVIDUAL LEARNING CONTENT CERTIFICATION PROCESS

- 1 Purpose. To describe the Joint Individual Learning Content Certification Process, to include requirements, funding, development, certification, and life cycle management; to identify the responsibilities of the Joint Staff/J-7, USJFCOM JWFC, combatant commands, Services, and CSAs.
- 2 Scope. This process applies to all organizations with a requirement for or providing joint individual learning content.
- 3 Responsibilities.
 - a. Joint Staff/J-7. Provide policy oversight and recommendations to Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness (OUSD (P&R)):
 - (1) Arbitrate requirement and resource conflicts among individual joint training stakeholders through the T2 governance and business processes. Enclosure P, Appendix A, provides more detail on the T2 business process and who the primary and advisory members that govern funding and provide management oversight.
 - b. USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C:
 - (1) Lead and manage the joint individual learning content certification process.
 - (2) Identify and review joint individual training requirements.
 - (3) Certify joint individual learning content.
 - (4) Enable access to joint individual learning content.
 - (5) Manage the joint individual learning database.
 - (6) Identify funding and management responsibility for the submitted joint individual learning content with the OPR.

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c. Combatant commands:

- (1) Submit joint individual training requirements to USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C, using the Joint Content Requirement Submission Sheet (JCRSS) form illustrated in Figure H-1.
- (2) Collaborate with USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C to identify potential funding sources for content development, media development and life cycle management for the submitted joint individual learning content.
- (3) Collaborate with OPR during the development, certification, and life cycle management process.
- (4) Submit any internally developed joint individual learning content for inclusion in the Certified Joint Individual Learning Content Database.

d. Services:

- (1) Submit joint individual training requirements to USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C.
- (2) Collaborate with USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C to identify potential funding sources for content development, media development and life cycle management for the submitted joint individual learning content.
- (3) Collaborate with OPR during the development, certification, and life cycle management process.
- (4) Submit any internally developed joint individual learning content for inclusion in the Certified Joint Individual Learning Content Database.

e. Combat Support Agencies:

- (1) Submit joint individual training requirements to USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C.
- (2) Collaborate with USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C to identify potential funding sources for content development, media development and life cycle management for the submitted joint individual learning content.
- (3) Collaborate with OPR during the development, certification, and life cycle management process. CSA subject matter expertise is essential to the development of joint learning content. Sponsorship and executive support to the OPR brings relevance and importance to the requirement for learning content development. (Note: DIA maintains Joint Individual Learning Content requirements in the Training Requirements Registry (TRR) within their Intelligence Education Center)
- (4) Submit any internally developed joint individual learning content for inclusion in the Certified Joint Individual Learning



4. Joint Individual Learning Content Certification Process.

a. Requirements:

(1) Combatant commands, Services, and CSA's will identify joint individual learning content requirements and submit a JCRSS to USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C.

(2) USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C will validate, analyze, prioritize, and provide a course of action to satisfy the individual joint training requirement.

b. Funding - In collaboration with the organization presenting the requirement, USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C and Joint Staff/J-7 will identify funding sources for content development, media development and life cycle management.

c. Development:

(1) The LDA will develop potential courses of action for USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C review using handbooks in the MIL-HDBK-29612 series as a guide.

(2) The LDA will identify the appropriate standard for the selected media and demonstrate compliance with that standard. (For example, the standard for distributed learning is DODI 1322.26)

(3) The LDA will coordinate with and seek feedback from the certification team during the development process.

d. Certification:

(1) Organizations will submit documentation supporting the five certification criteria for new or existing training content to the certification team using the JCRSS. See Figure H-1 for sample JCRSS.

(2) Certification Criteria.

(a) Content must meet a joint training requirement.

(b) Content should not conflict with joint doctrine. In every case, training content must support emerging concepts of high or special interest to the joint warfighting community.

(c) Joint training objectives must link to current UJTL.

(d) Media must incorporate assessment of each trainee to track achievement of the training objectives.

(e) Media must support content assessment as part of life cycle management.

(3) The certification team will review the joint training material and the CRSS and provide feedback as required.

(4) The USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C certification team will enter



all certified training into the Certified Joint Individual Learning Database and notify the LDA.

e. Life Cycle Management:

(1) Training customers will identify and access joint training through the Certified Joint Individual Learning Database.

Training customer feedback to the OPR on learning content currency, improvements, and potential interaction with Service training programs will support the further development of the Joint Individual Learning Database.

(2) Training providers will track and report proficiency and completion data to USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C.

(3) The OPR for the training is responsible for notifying USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C of content changes to incorporate feedback from execution and joint doctrinal changes; USJFCOM will incorporate changes to content.

(4) USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C certification team will periodically audit all content in the Certified Joint Individual Learning Database to validate certification and will report the results to the Joint training community.

(5) The OPR can request removal of content from the Certified Joint Individual Learning Database. USJFCOM JWFC J7/JT-05C will evaluate the impact of removal and report that impact to the Joint training community.
