Dr. Joseph J. Collins is currently Professor of Strategy at the National War College in Washington, DC. From 2001 to 2004, he was Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Stability Operations and very active in plans and policy for the war in Afghanistan, as well as in the initial planning for Operation *Iraqi Freedom*. A retired Army colonel, he is a veteran of over a decade's service in the Pentagon, and has taught at the United States Military Academy at West Point, Georgetown University, and Columbia University.
