
5.41 MASTERS' DEGREES

1. On 30 November 1993, President Clinton signed legislation providing the President of the National Defense University the authority to confer the degrees of Master of Science in National Resource Strategy and Master of Science in National Security Strategy.
2. The President of the University confers the degrees upon recommendation of the faculty, academic deans, and commandants of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces and the National War College.
 - a. Degree requirements for students include:
 - (1) Successful completion of at least four college approved advanced study courses or equivalent research projects.
 - (2) Successful completion of all reading and writing assignments.
 - (3) Successful completion of assessments.
 - (4) Recommendation of the faculty and the Commandant to the President, National Defense University for the granting of a degree.
3. The National Defense University is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools.
