

**Purpose:** Provide the NDU Board of Visitors an overview of the NDU iCollege

**Mission:** The NDU Information Resources Management College (NDU iCollege) prepares military and civilian leaders to optimize information technology management and secure information dominance within cyberspace.

**Key Areas of Focus:** Develop mid-to-senior leaders and decision makers in areas of information, IT, cyber and financial management leaders who have the ability to operate and creatively think in an unpredictable and complex world.

**Education Programs:** Seminar based, interactive/experiential learning.

- Offer Master’s of Science (Government Information Leadership), Certificates and Professional Development education in:
  - Chief Information Officer
  - Chief Financial Officer
  - Cyber Leadership
  - Cyber Security
  - Enterprise Architecture
  - IT Program Management
- Prepare graduates who will:
  - Shape tomorrow by understanding and leveraging commander’s intent and key information, IT and financial resource enablers
  - Lead, anticipate, and respond to change
  - Recognize and manage risk amidst uncertainty
  - Effectively communicate with leaders and decision makers
  - Make ethical decisions based on the shared values of the Profession of Arms
- 40 different courses with over 200 offerings/year

**Flexible Learning Options:** Student centered to meet their ops tempo needs and resource constraints:

- Full time: 14 weeks (Advanced Management Program – Chief Information Officer Certificate)
- Full time: 10 months (Master’s Degree in Cyber Leadership; Potential JPME Program)
- Part time: eResident (5 weeks (1 week in-residence, 4 weeks on-line) - 3 credit course)  
Distributed Learning (12 week interactive on-line seminar - 3 credit course)  
Electives (6 week in-resident seminar – 2 credit course)
- Education in Context: Courses designed for key stakeholders (CYBERCOM, Air Force, etc)
- 4 years to complete a Certificate; 7 years to complete the Master’s Degree
- Many students continually return for courses to keep relevant in these dynamic domains
- Academic Partners: Students may transfer 9 – 15 credits to over 30 partner Universities for a technical or nontechnical Master’s or Ph.D. program if a student prefers to earn a degree in a different but related field
