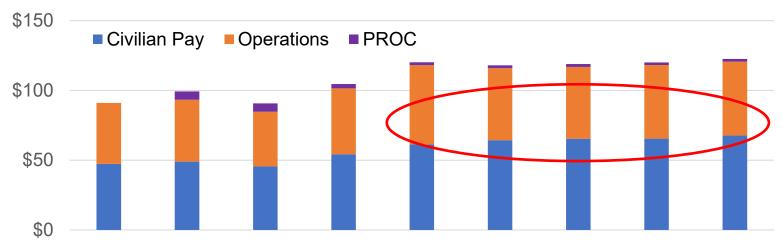

### **FY23 Highlights**





- Executing a FY23 \$5.7M Operations & Maintenance (O&M)
  program increase for facilities sustainment, restoration and
  modernization (FSRM)
- Leveraged a \$50M Congressional Appropriation to break ground on the Eisenhower Hall restoration and modernization project
- Completed an updated cost model that captures costs for support to reimbursable customers that delivers an additional \$1.8M
- Delivering a 16% increase in Civilian Pay execution from \$45.5M in FY22 to an estimated \$53M in FY23

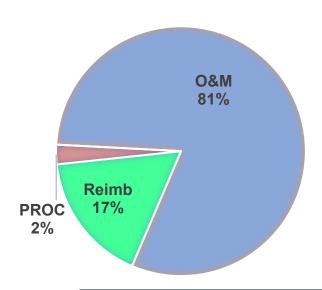

## FY23 NDU Funding - Sources and Uses

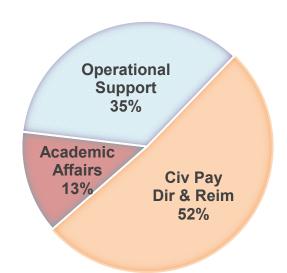

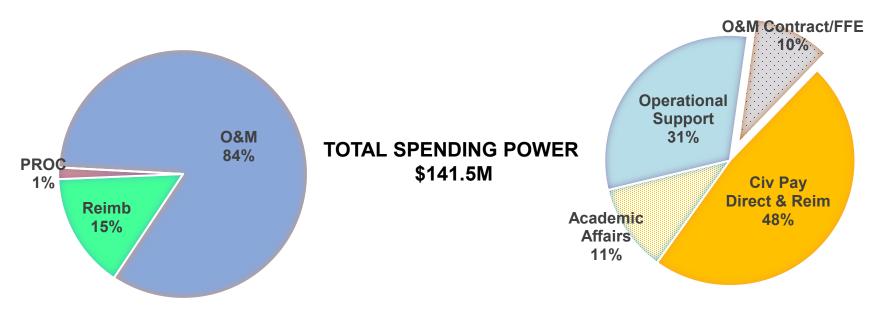
